Seeing God's Image in Others

We hope you can join us on June 10-12 for the 2022 ICC Congregational Retreat! This is one of the best weekends on our church calendar not only because it gives us a chance to unplug from the busyness of the daily grind, but it is an opportunity to strengthen our faith, build our community and nurture our souls. After taking two years off due to COVID, we are eager to see our family of faith come together for an awesome time of worship, growth, fun and fellowship.

The theme for this year's retreat is "*Seeing God's Image in Others.*" While you may have encountered enneagrams in non-church settings, we believe that this is a unique tool that has the potential to reveal things about ourselves and how we are wired which can help us in our spiritual formation and growing in Christ-likeness. Everyone will be asked to take the Enneagram test prior to the retreat.



Aurum Laguna will be our main speaker along with his wife Sarah. Aurum served as the community and outreach pastor at ICC from 2007 to 2014 and is currently an assistant pastor at Sunset Church in San Francisco with a focus on small groups and discipleship. He is an expert in enneagrams and passionate about how it can be used as a spiritual tool for our own edification and in our relationships with others. Aurum graduated with a civil engineering degree from the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign in 2001 and completed a Masters from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School in 2011. God has given Aurum a heart for shepherding and guiding the church to be healthy, vibrant and passionate for Christ and His mission. He and Sarah have two sons and a daughter and he enjoys playing sports, cheering for his Chicago teams, and has a deep appreciation for good pizza, coffee and movies.

During the retreat, Aurum will not only help us to understand Enneagrams (along with our specific Enneagram type), but present it to us through a biblical framework. Aurum and his wife, Sarah, will team teach the Saturday afternoon session, sharing via testimony how Enneagrams have helped them not only in their marriage but in their broader relationships with others.



* The high school will join the adults for all sessions and have their own small groups. The middle school (rising 6th-8th graders) will have their own separate program during the main sessions.




