

Eternal Life

John 10:10, The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.

John 17:1-3, After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you. 2 For you granted him authority over all people that he might give eternal life to all those you have given him. 3 Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.

2 Corinthians 5:17, Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

Galatians 2:20, I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

- 2. What were your thoughts on witnessing the baptisms at the Easter service? What impact did your own baptism have on your faith?
- 3. Read John 10:10 and John 17:1-3. Jesus describes eternal life as abundant life—a life that is richer because we know God. In what ways have you experienced this abundance in your life?
- 4. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17 and Galatians 2:20. What are the significant changes you've experienced as a result of being a new creation in Christ?
