Then Peter remembered the word Jesus had spoken: “Before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times.” And **he went outside and wept bitterly.**







“Don’t be alarmed,” he said. “You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. But go, tell his disciples **and Peter**, ‘He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.’”
