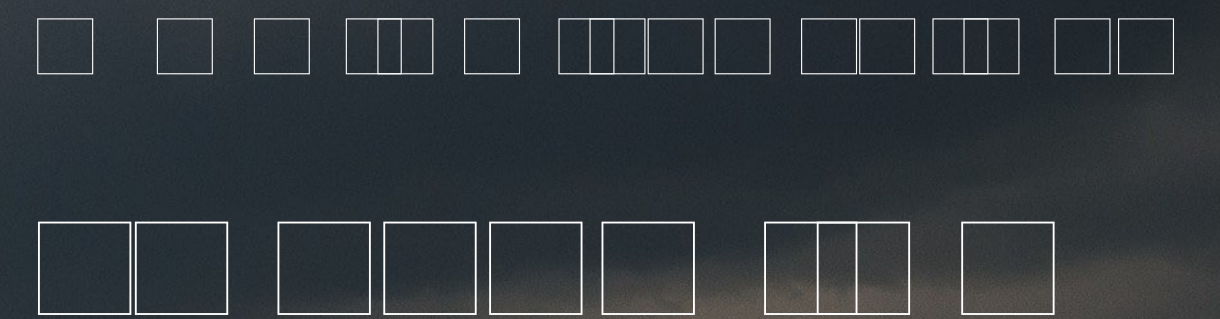

... A fallen world is intrinsically defined by wickedness. If there were no wickedness, the world would not be fallen. No matter how much wickedness God might eliminate, we could always find more wicked people to complain about (defining “the wicked” as anyone we see as more wicked than ourselves).
