POSITION: Literacy Tutor

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend 16 hours of mandatory tutor training
- Follow course of instruction as outlined by the site supervisor
- Provide written information weekly as to progress made on provided lesson plan
- Assist learner with additional skills related to personal education needs and goals, i.e., letter writing, job applications, etc.
- Notify site supervisor prior to any necessary absence
- Provide own transportation to and from site

TIME REQUIREMENT: 2.5 to 3 hours per week at the site

LENGTH OF COMMITMENT: 10 weeks (not always consecutive weeks)

TRAINING:

- Pre-Service: Two 45-minute online workshops
- Introductory Part I: Attend one 7.5 hour day of workshops
- Introductory Part II: Attend 30 minute workshop prior to each tutoring session (10 weeks)
- Introductory Part III: Shadow experienced volunteer tutor for one class (2.5 hours)
- Additional in-service workshops offered throughout the year that address specialized teaching methods, techniques and theories

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Ability to read Independent mobility
- Belief that adults can learn Patience
- Cooperative Good hygiene
- Desire to help others Willingness to learn
- Empathy Enthusiasm
- Flexibility
- Adherence to the above duties, responsibilities, time commitment, and attendance at mandatory completion of 16-hour training
